The weather was wonderful for the Reception to Year 5 swimming program that ran at Salisbury Swim Centre last week. Our students thoroughly enjoyed the lessons and it was pleasing to see children learning new skills and becoming increasingly confident in the water. The instructors commented on the excellent behaviour of our students and their willingness to listen to and follow the instructions that keep everyone safe around water. It is very important in Australia that every person attains the skills and knowledge to be safe in and around water. Your willingness to not attend the lessons helped your children to develop their independence and enabled many of the students to give their full attention to the swimming instructors.
